

## Directions to ComputerWorld Wales from Newport, Bristol and London

- Leave the M4 at Junction 29 onto the A48M.
- Continue along and take the left-hand slip road onto the A4161, signposted Cardiff East/Docks.
- Move into right hand lane (signed A4232) passing over flyover. At first roundabout take the second exit marked **Docks**. Follow road for 2.5 miles, following Park and Ride/Docks signs.
- At next roundabout take second exit.
- At next roundabout straight on.
- At next roundabout take the second exit marked Cardiff Bay/ Centre.
- You are now on Ocean Way. Take the next turn left (approx 300 metres) into Nettlefold Road. (If you reach the "Magic Roundabout" of sculptures made out of traffic signs you have gone too far)
- Take first left (approx 100 metres) onto Vanguard Way.
- **Parking is available on the road outside the Business Park**
- CWL House is through the automatic barrier and turn right, we are about 50 metres along on the left-hand side.

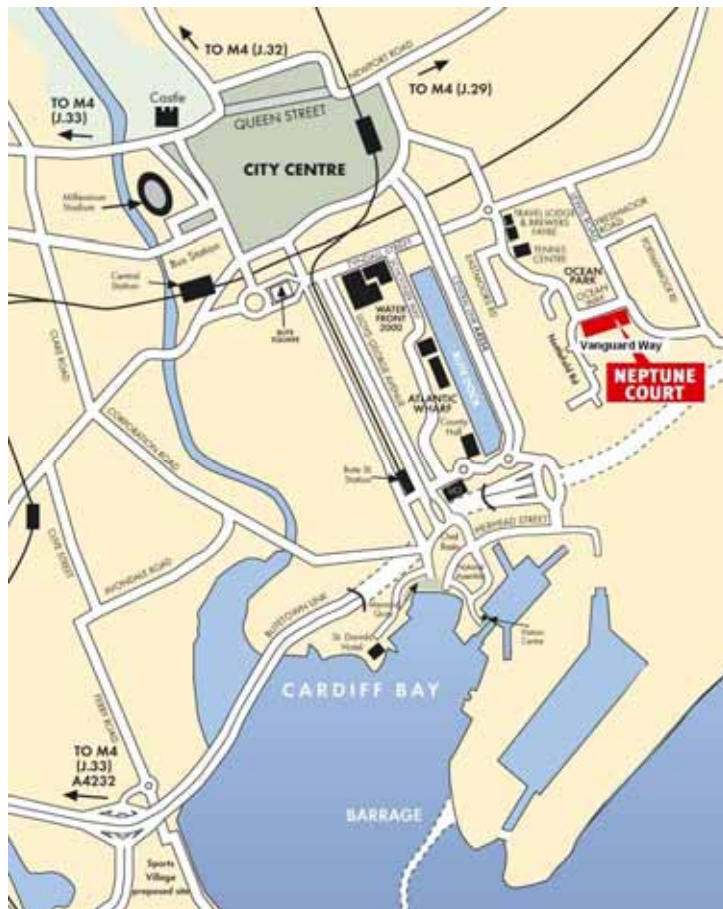

## Directions to ComputerWorld Wales from Bridgend, Swansea and west Wales

- Leave the M4 at Junction 33 onto the A4232. Follow this road all the way to Cardiff Bay, going through the Queen's Gate tunnel.
- On leaving the tunnel you come to a large roundabout. Following the signs for the City Centre, take the first exit and at the next roundabout take the second exit onto the Central Link.
- Proceed along the Central Link in the left hand lane. Before you reach the flyover, take the left-hand filter lane signposted Splott and Ocean Park.
- Take the third (right-hand) exit from the roundabout towards Splott and the "Magic Roundabout" of sculptures made out of traffic signs.
- At the "Magic Roundabout" take the third exit (right-hand) onto Ocean Way, signposted Ocean Park
- Shortly after passing the national tennis centre on your left take the next right-hand turn into Nettlefold Road.
- Continue along Nettlefold Road for some 100 metres before turning left onto Vanguard Way.
- **Parking is available on the road outside the Business Park**
- CWL House is through the automatic barrier and turn right, we are about 50 metres along on the left-hand side.

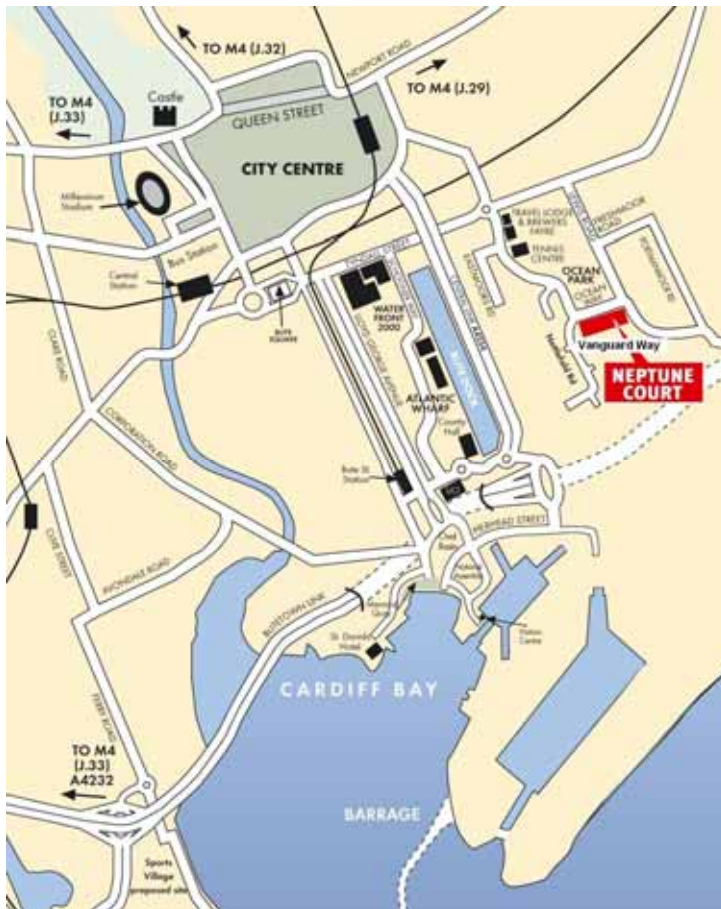

## Directions to ComputerWorld Wales from Merthyr Tydfil and Mid Wales along the A470

- Take the A470 towards the City Centre (North Road).
- Just before the Hilton Hotel turn left at the Civic Centre into Boulevard de Nantes. As you turn Cardiff castle will be on your right
- Proceed through two junctions controlled by traffic lights, and then under a railway bridge onto Newport Road. Ensure you are in the right-hand lane.
- Turn right into Fitzalan Place and proceed between the Law Courts and Prison.
- Travel straight through the next junction onto Windsor Road with Rumpoles public house on the left-hand corner and the fire station to your right.
- Continue along Windsor Road to the “Magic Roundabout” of sculptures made out of traffic signs.
- At the “Magic Roundabout” take second exit (straight ahead) onto Ocean Way.
- Shortly after passing the national tennis centre on your left take the next right-hand turn onto Nettlefold Road.
- Continue along Nettlefold Road for some 100 metres before turning left onto Vanguard Way.
- **Parking is available on the road outside the Business Park**
- CWL House is through the automatic barrier and turn right, we are about 50 metres along on the left-hand side.
